RESIDENTIAL COLLEGE Private Party Registration

One must register a private party of 20 or more people. A party must not at any time exceed a maximum limit of 50 people as stated in the Undergraduate Regulations. It is the Head of College's prerogative to set a lower maximum limit.

Party registration forms must be submitted during normal business hours in the Dean's Office at least 48 hours prior to the party. A copy of the form must be provided to the Head of College and Dean of the College, posted in the Entryway where the party will take place, and provided to the Custodial Supervisor.
